Hi golfing divas! It's that time of the year where we work on our weaknesses and store away our cute summer golf outfits. It's time to replace our summer wardrobe with warm, winter-weather-friendly glam gear. We are going to rock our lights and brights on-course this off-season! Oh, and those sparkly skinny jeans aren't just for dinner with the girls...

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PUTTING IN A SWEATER DRESS
Sweater dresses are perfect for on-course wow and warmth. They come in all kinds of designs and patterns; find the right one for you! I threw on some fun chandelier earrings to sparkle the outfit up; do the same! Sweater dresses are thick, but can still be feminine and stylish. You probably have a bunch in your closet already, and if not, they are totally trending right now.

GOLF TIP
Visualize an imaginary line from the ball to the hole; make sure you read the break! Place your ball down, and using the words on the side of the ball, match them to your imaginary line. Set up with your putter over the ball and align the face on your putter face to the line on your ball. Commit to the line; be comfortable at set-up. Go ahead and stroke your putter and knock your ball in the hole!




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CHIP-TASTIC IN PURPLE
Purple Passion Fashion can last all year! Purple never goes out of season, so take advantage of all the purple in your closet, and bring it to the course. Purple is a great color because it is royal and warm, especially dark purples. I'm wearing a purple long-sleeve dress with heavy lace accents on the shoulders and sleeves. I've accented the dress with a purple shiny glove from GloveIt, purple and white FootJoy two-tone shoes, a matching Titleist visor and my Chanel sparkly flower earrings.


GOLF TIP
A "short chip" is a shot played around the green, and means that the ball is close to the hole. You cannot putt it as yet, but you can hit the short chip shot. Take a wedge with 60, 58, or 56 degrees in loft and address the ball. Keep your wrists firm and the ball in the center of your stance. Commit to your practice strokes and get a feel for the distance of the shot. Short back and short through with good rhythm always helps.



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TEE AND TARGET IN TUXEDO
Wearing a tuxedo to tee-time is very appropriate! You can never go wrong with black and white to close with another fairway hit. I'm wearing high-waisted glitter pants with a target print shoulderless turtleneck top. My FootJoy black and white patent leather shoes shine from the tee to green. To accessorize I have a simple black Titleist visor, sparkly studs and a grey and diamond beaded necklace. This outfit is right on target!


GOLF TIP
With the tee and ball in one hand, put your tee in the ground so that your ball is stable and strong. Make sure to keep the height of your tee and ball proportionate to the height of your driver; it can be slightly taller too because you are swinging up on the ball and a driver has little loft. I suggest using a 2 3/4 inch tee when teeing up your driver. There are tees that are longer and shorter, but this length seems to work the best.




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MAKE IMPACT IN SPARKLY JEANS
Yes, ladies, you can wear jeans on the course, as long as they don't look like jeans! If they are stretchy and sparkly, they can be referred to as "jeggings," a cross between "jeans" and "leggings." Jeggings are comfy, they fit well and you can swing and squat in them. I am wearing a burgundy fitted long-sleeve top with lace sleeves. I have my basic white patent leather FootJoy shoes and a basic white Titleist visor so I can let my sparkly jeans take most of the attention!

GOLF TIP
It is fun when you are able to "strike" the golf ball well; that is what I call "Making an Impact!" At impact, it is important to have a good grip on your club. When you are at impact, your left arm should be bold and strong, your left wrist should feel unbreakable. Stay strong with your left arm and feel the power of the left arm at impact. Make sure you are relaxed and have chosen your target. Swing away!

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DRIVE FOR SHOW

FASHION TIP
Active print is a "Seema Style" must. Golf fashion is about making new fashion rules for you. Gold, black, white and silver are golf's most elegant colors for on course play. Be you and be comfortable when you play golf. As a woman, I'm inspired to create and build my sense of style and I encourage you to do the same.

GOLF TIP
You have to drive for show before you can putt for dough! Before hitting my driver, I make sure to stand behind my ball and pick out my "intermediate target"—an exact spot you pick out in front of your ball that lines you up to where you see your ball landing in the fairway. It can be a blade of grass, a divot or a bug! Your target will help you align your feet, shoulders and clubface to your spot on the fairway. This part of hitting your driver is just as important as your swing.

CHIPPING IN BLACK AND NEON

FASHION TIP
Don't be afraid to step for golf inspiration in your closet. We have golf outfits ready to go, you just don't know it. I'm wearing a leopard print black Lynn body suit. I paired it with a grey Lynn Lovers fully running shirt to give my outfit the complete sporty-chic look. I've accented my basic black ensemble with an orange hole around my waist and neon green custom FootJoy shoes.


GOLF TIP
Chipping is so easy and fun to practice. Place the ball in the back of your stance, keep your hands and weight forward and use your left hand to drive through. Keep good tempo and commit to a short and smooth stroke. Visualize a four-foot circle around the hole so your target looks bigger!

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TAP OUT IN STYLE

FASHION TIP
I'm wearing a wrap-neck, sparkly dress with falling, sheer under-mesh. Women tend to have lots of dresses in their closets, and if the dress is stretchy and comfortable, get the right pair of spandex to wear underneath and hit the links!

GOLF TIP
The path to "good" in competition. There are three easy steps to making holes for us. Step 1: Squat behind the ball, visualize the ground and drive it low then go a third the ball is going to travel as it falls into the cup. Step 2: Place your feet behind the ball and line the center of the putter to your feet. Back your head down the line. Step 3: Using your shoulder and keeping your body still, rock your putter back and forth. Be smooth, and stay committed to your stroke!




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
